- Technical expertise with a variety of insurance coverages and analysis of risk exposures.
- The position requires ability and willingness to travel domestically and internationally up to 5% of the time.

- Ability to adapt to a changing environment and handle a high volume of work through prioritization and project management.
- Excellent communication and analytical skills.
- Technical knowledge of property, casualty and / or specialty insurance coverage.
